BUILDING THE TEMPLE OF THE GODS

1 – The Temple



Print out all the pages you need. Some pages have to be printed several times. Every page tells how often it needs to be printed.



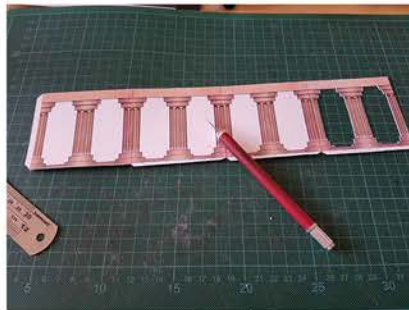
Cut out the outer walls with the pillars. As you can see, the glue tabs for the floor are made up of triangular teeth...



You can cut them out, if you want to build a round temple. For a square temple, simply cut in a straight line along the tips.



Score the wall segments, fold them over, and glue them together, as well as into one piece. Make sure to leave the "dull" end open.



Cut out the white spaces in between the pillars. Use a sharp hobby knife to do so.



Fold back the outer wall segments, so the glue tabs for the floor face inwards. Blacken all edges with a marker.



Build the other half of the outer walls exactly like you just did the pillars. Cut out the round window openings.



Build the inner wall and mount the outer walls to it, glueing the taps into the dull ends of the outer wall segments, and the taps of the outer walls into one another.



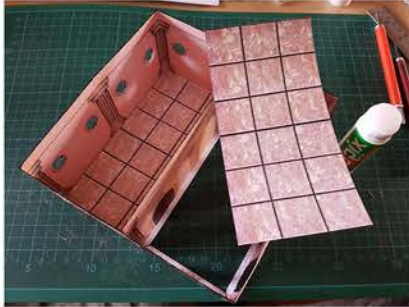
Cut out the two floor parts of the temple.

BUILDING THE TEMPLE OF THE GODS

1 – The Temple (continued)



Glue the floor parts into the rooms of the temple.



OPTIONAL: Cut out and build the small wall, if you want to divide the back room into a separate study and bedroom. You can also open the door.



Glue the small wall into the back room, dividing it evenly. Orient the wall piece at the middle pillar.

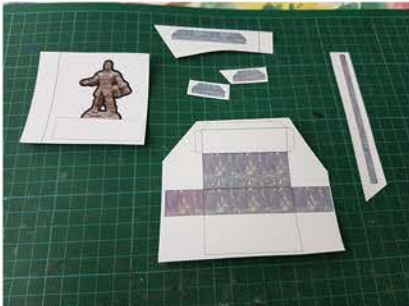


Mount the temple step surface to a piece of thick cardboard or foamcore.

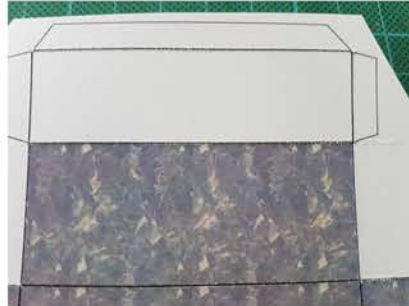


Cut the step out and glue the temple to the center of this base.

2 – The Altar



Cut out the parts of the altar. You can choose between 7 different types of gods, with the additional option of male or female for each type.



Score the parts before cutting them out. The smaller parts might otherwise be too flimsy to score later on.



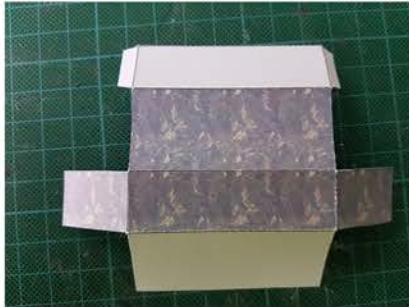
Cut out the statue of the god of your choice and mount it to thick cardboard or foamcore.

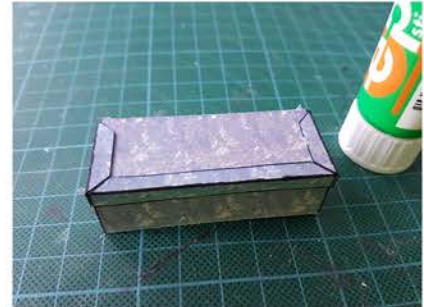
2 – The Altar (continued)



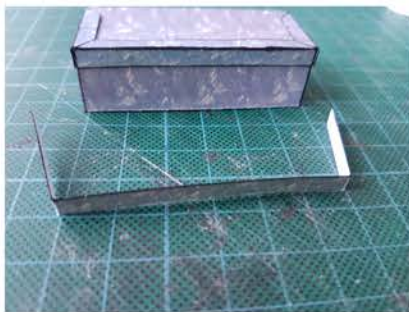
Cut out the altar, fold it, and glue it together into a box.



Cut out the parts for the top of the altar. Fold them and blacken the edges.



Glue the parts to the top edge of the altar, the small ones to the sides and the long one to the front.



Cut out and fold the lower lining of the altar, blacken the edges, and glue it to the box.



Glue the reinforced statue of the god to the backside of the altar.

3 – The Priests



Cut out the priest, score along the red line, and fold the miniature over.



Glue the miniature together and trim it to the black edge.



Blacken the edges and base the mini, for example using clear plastic feet from www.spielmaterial.de, or with paper bases from onemonk.com/bases.html.

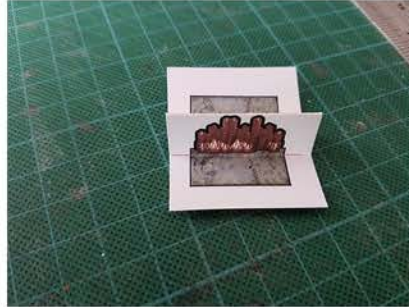

4 – The Candles



You will find plenty of candles on the pages of this playset. Cut them out and score along the red lines.

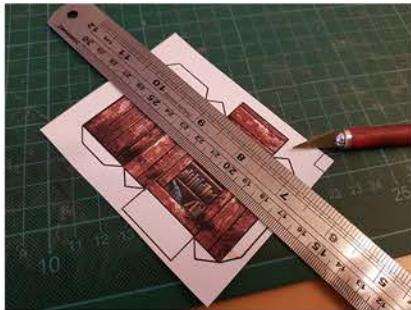


Fold over along the middle and out along the base part. Glue the upper part together.



Trim to the black border and blacken the edges.

5 – The Furniture



Score and cut out the furniture pieces.



Glue them into their box shape. All the different pieces are basically built the same way.

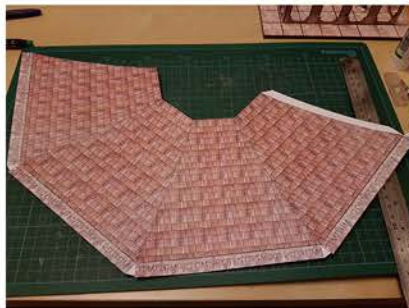


For the bed, build the end pieces and simply glue them to the bed box. In case of the chair you first build the box and then wrap the rest around it.

6 – The Roof



Cut out and score the four parts of the roof.



Glue the parts together, so you get a four-sided roof with a square oculus in the top and a rim with inscription at the bottom.



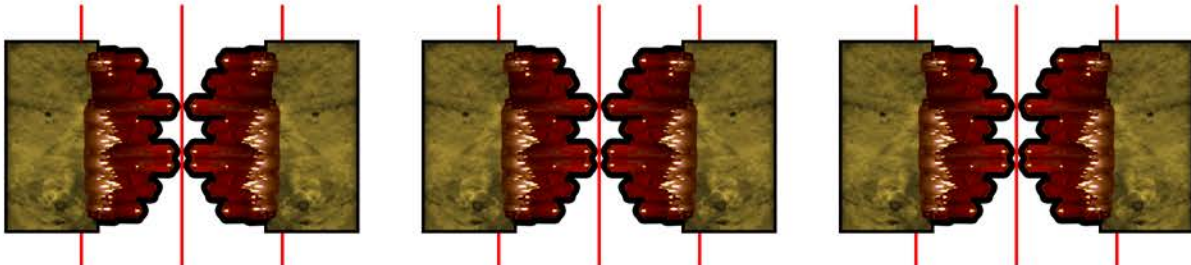
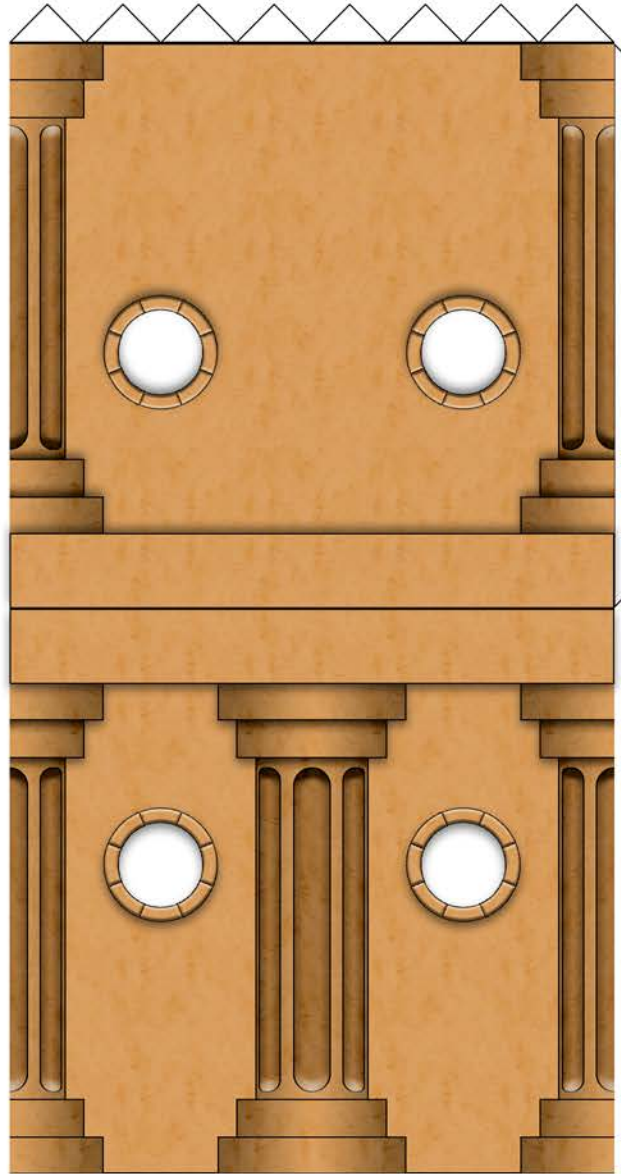
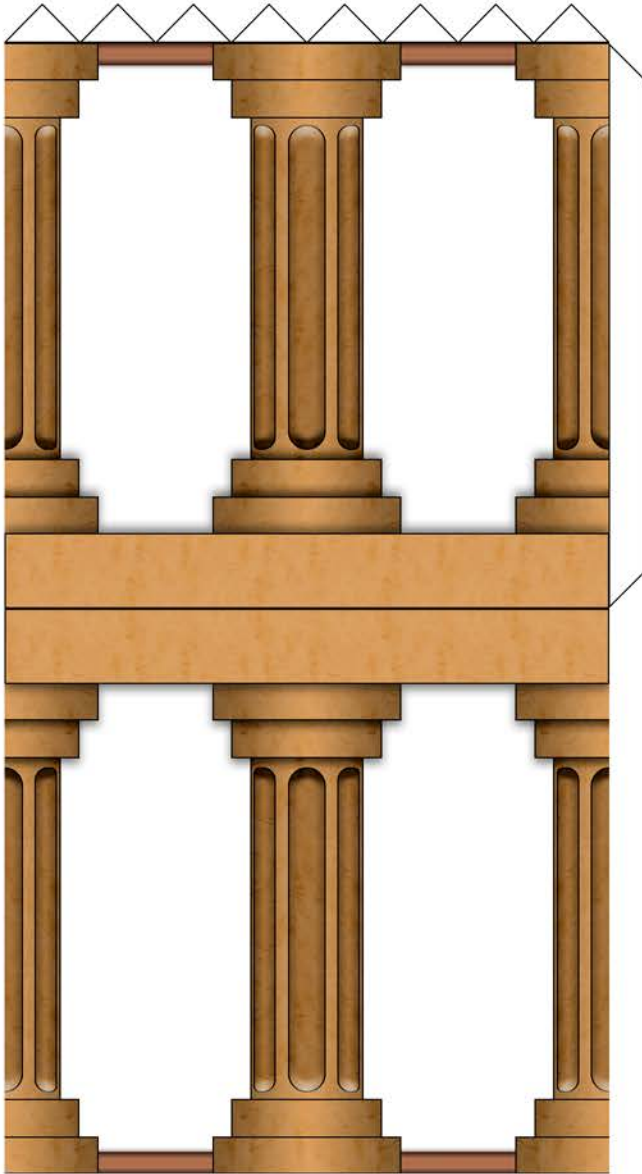
Blacken the edges and put the roof onto the temple. You can remove it anytime to reveal the inner rooms of the sacred building.

Outer Walls: Print this page 4 times.

The wall piece with the pillars is used for the side of the temple that contains the altar. The other wall piece is for the back room that contains the study and living area of the priests.

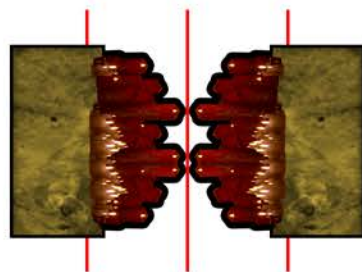
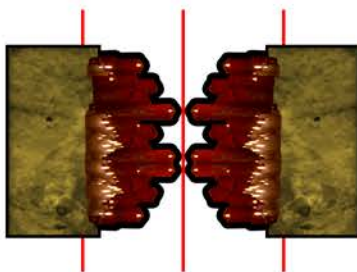
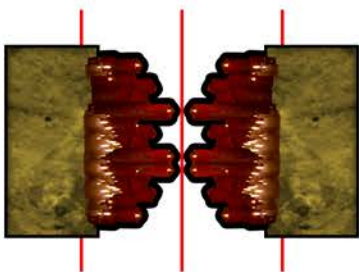
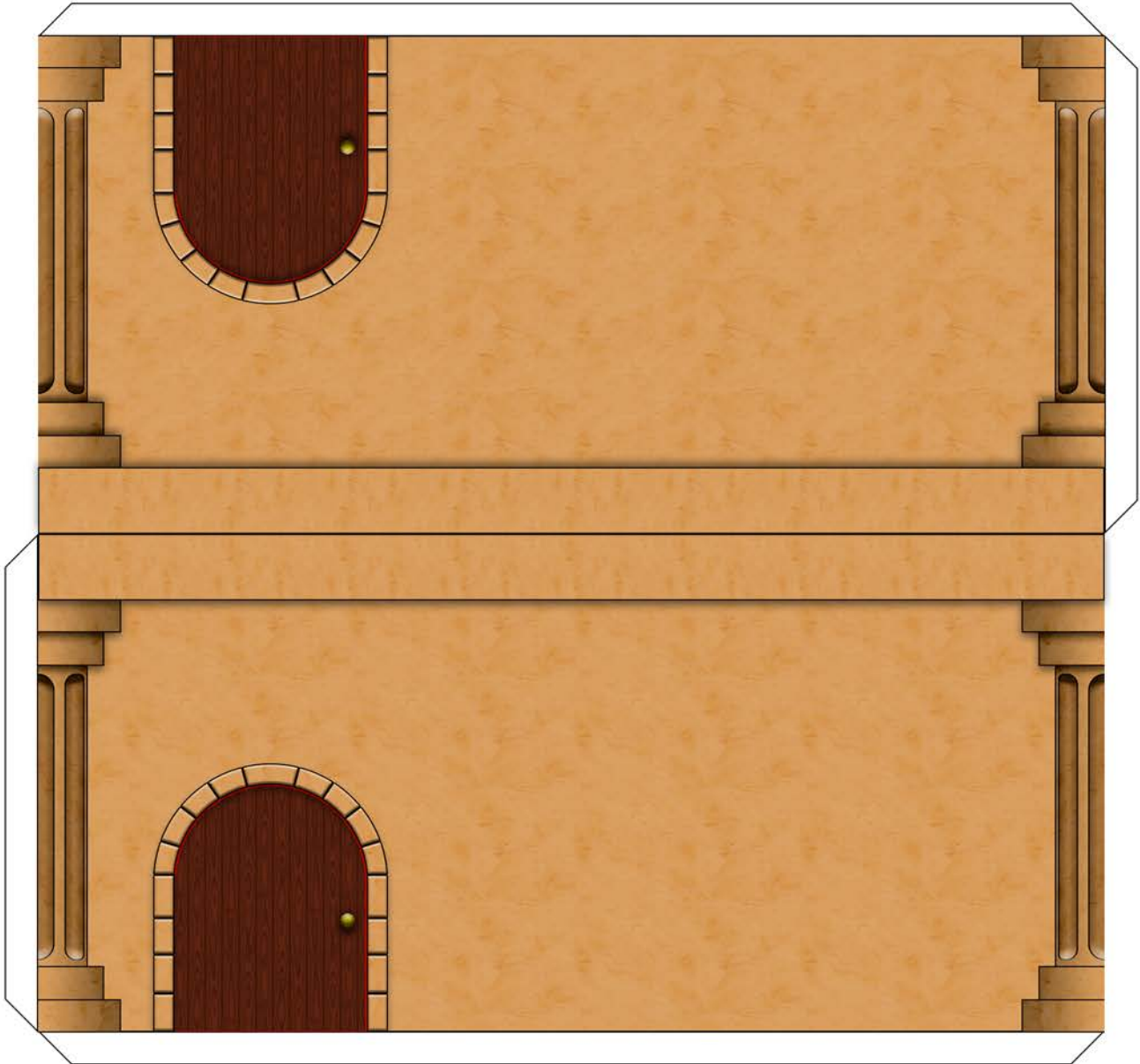

Inner Wall: Print this page once.

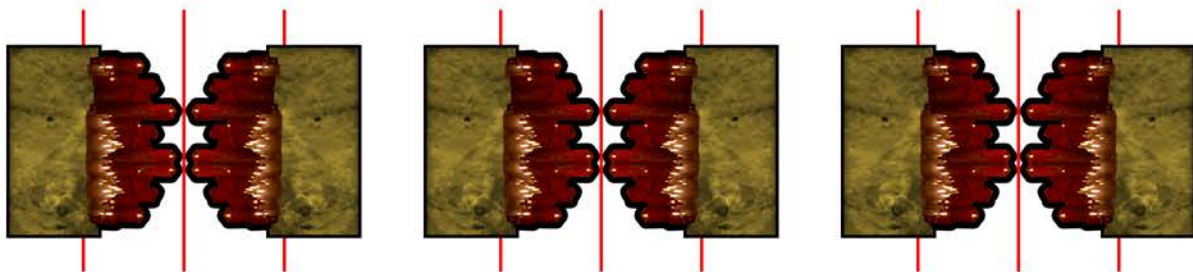
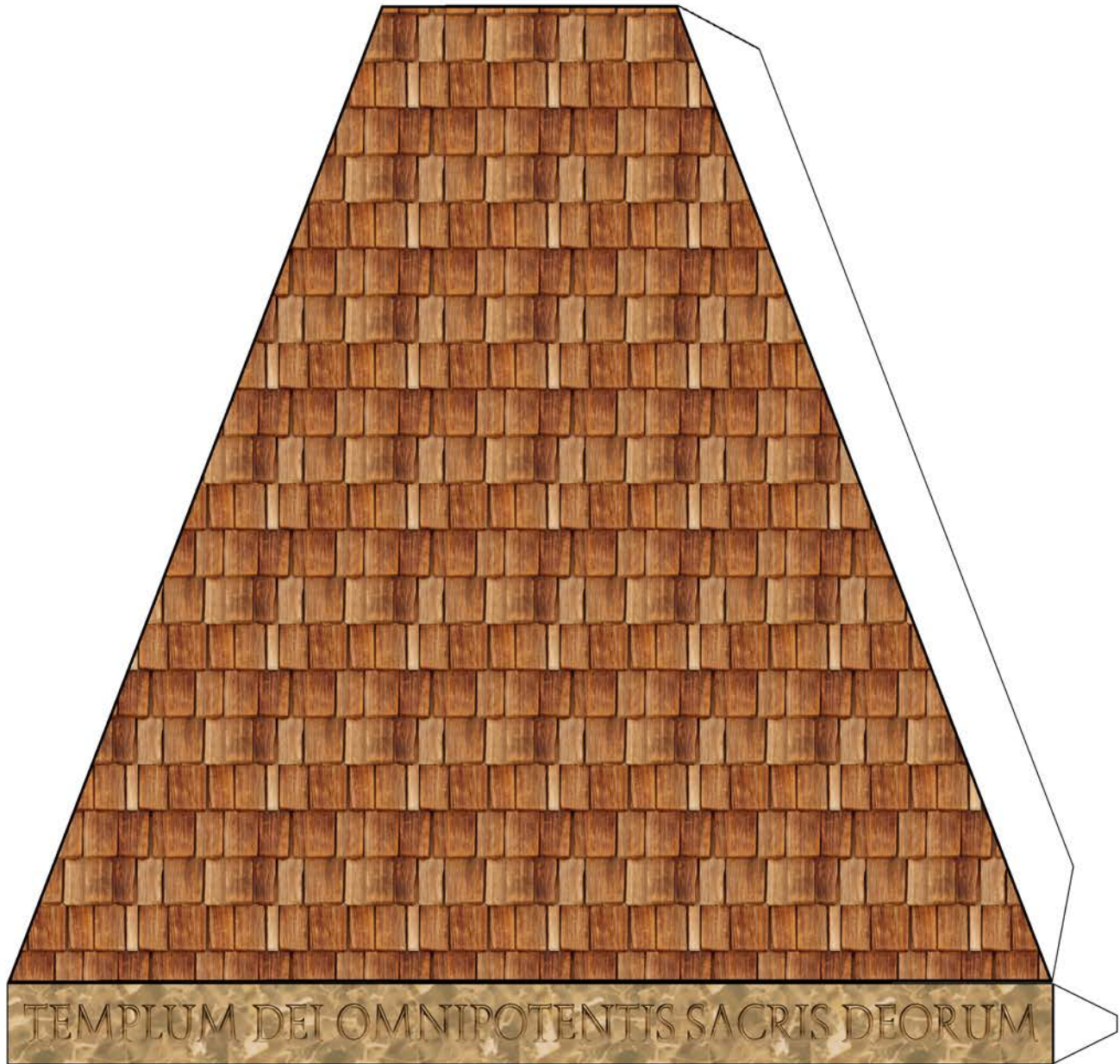
The inner wall separates the open altar room from the living quarter of the priests.

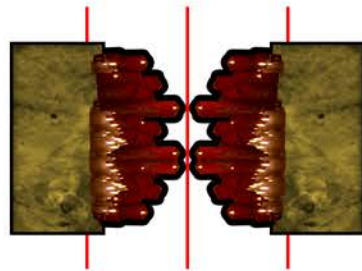
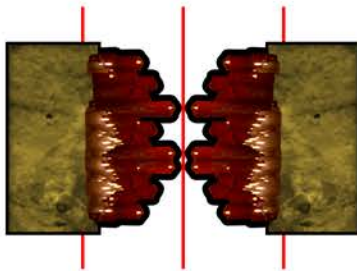
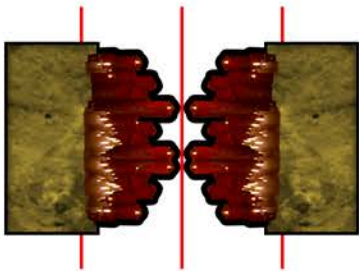
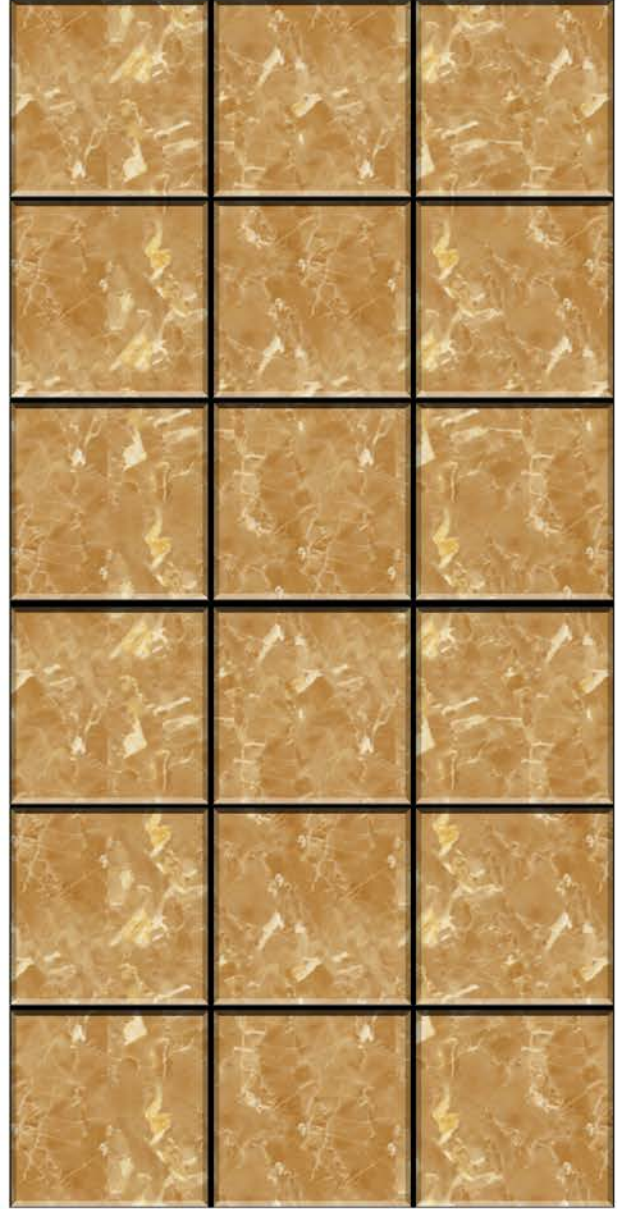
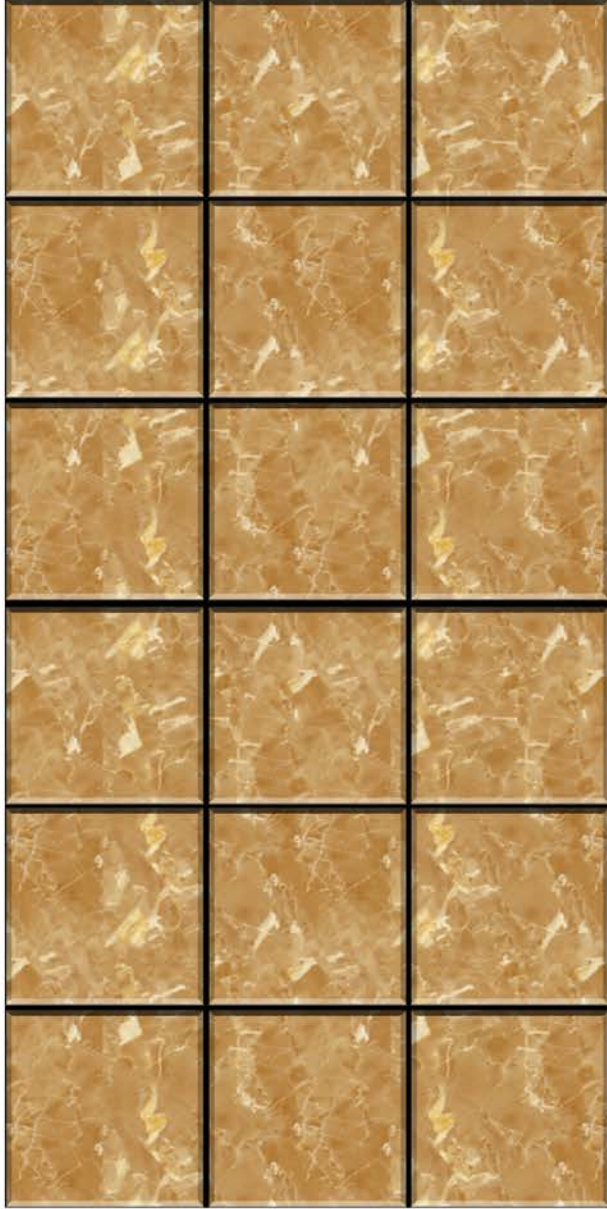
Roof: Print this page 4 times.

Inner Floor: Print this page once.

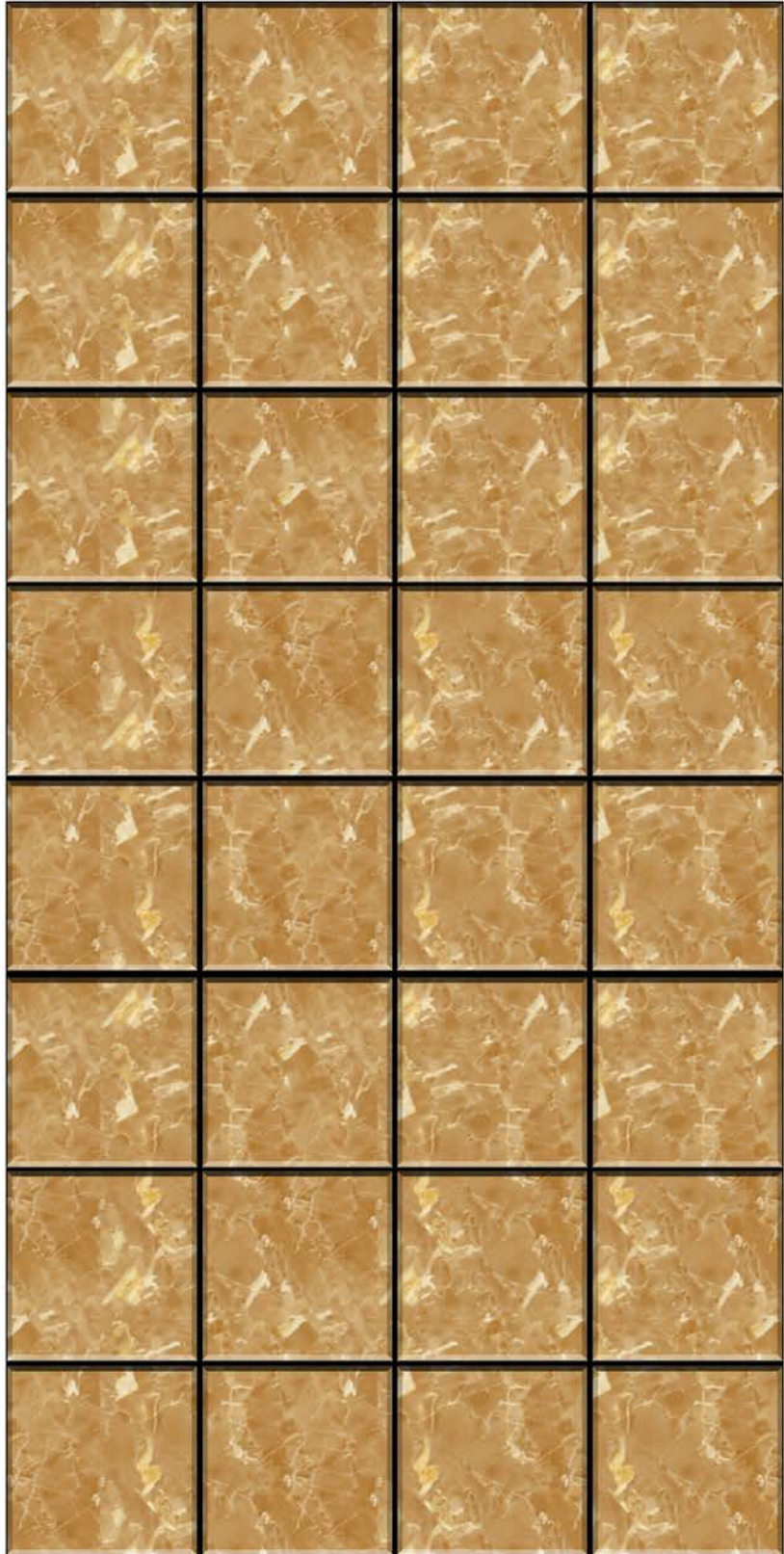
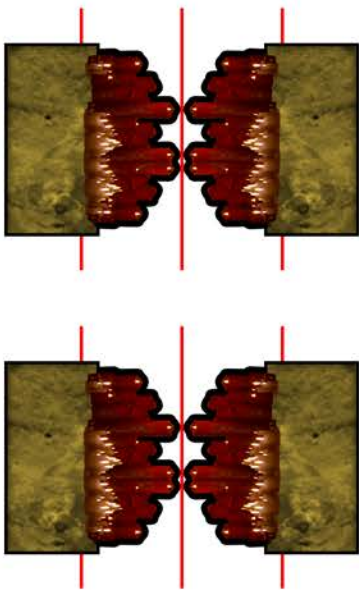

Temple Step I: Print this page once.

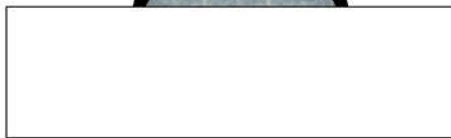
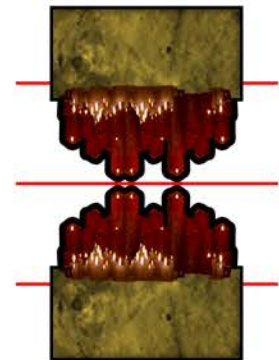
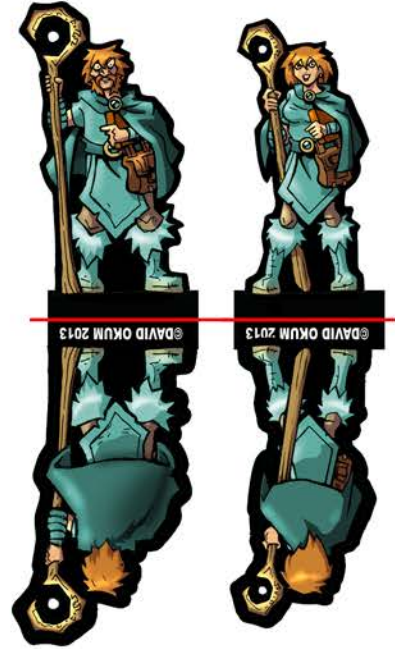
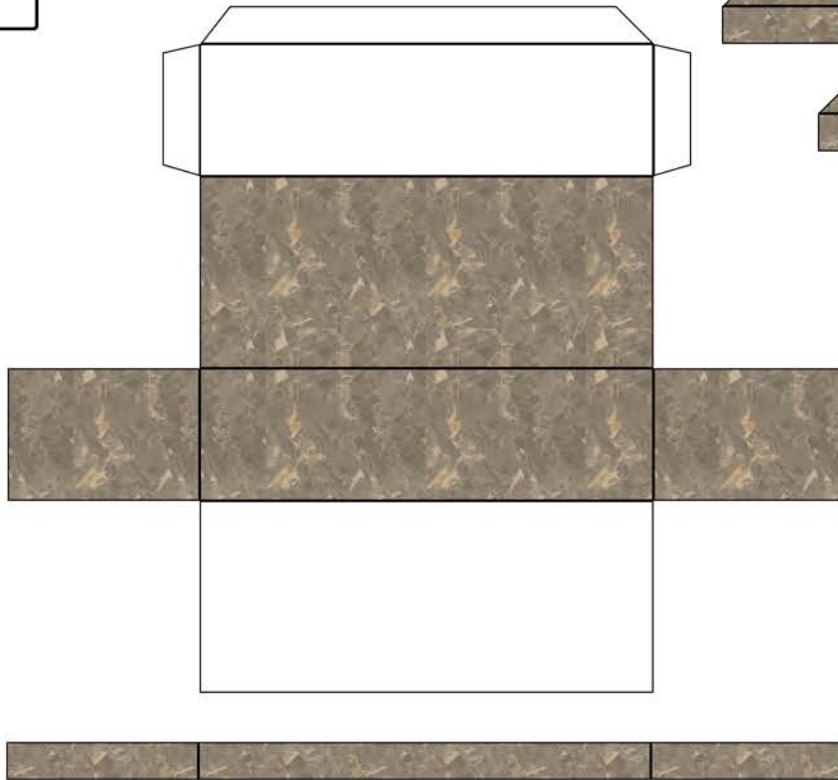
Optional Inner Wall: Print this page once.

You can insert this optional wall into the priests's quarters to separate the study from the bedroom.



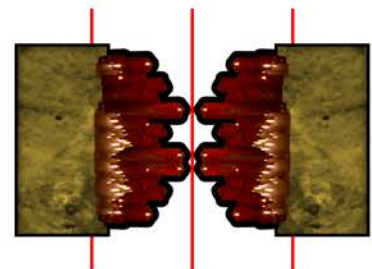
