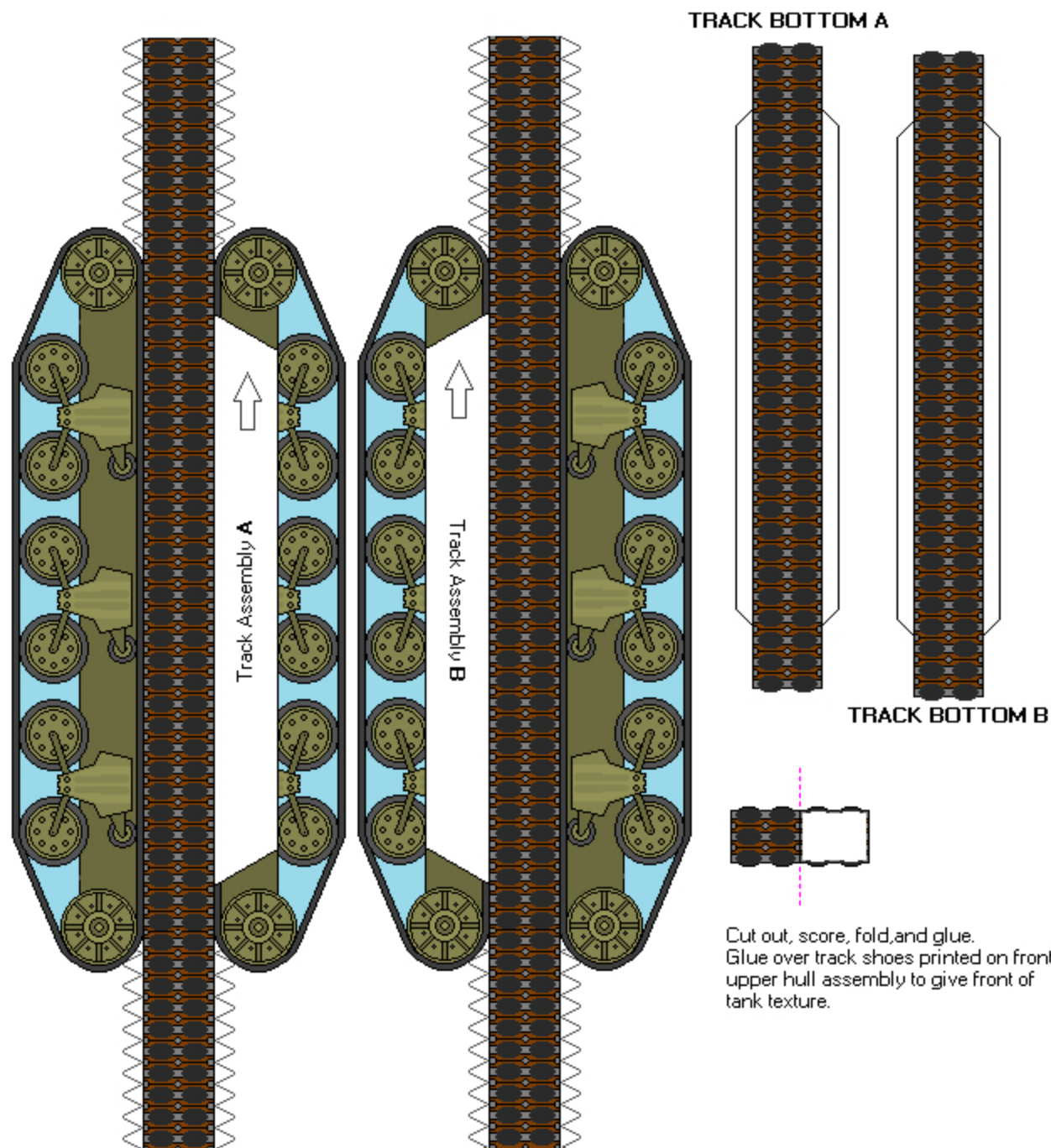


M-IV HERMAN MEDIUM TANK



G: Track Assemblies

Track assemblies can be assembled at any time, but should be added to the lower hull assembly as the last step of assembling your tank. Assemble the track assembly first, then add the track bottom. Scoring the track edges and curving the trailing pieces of track by curling them over the edge of a curved straight-edge like a pencil will make assembly much easier. Glue track bottoms into place securely and allow to dry upside down.

Center Track Assemblies against LowerHull Assembly, keeping them even front to rear, with the arrows pointing towards the front of the tank. This should be the last step in assembling your tank.

F: Commander's Gun

The Commander's Gun is a tricky bit of detail for on top of the turret. The .30 calibre machine gun is easy enough to cut out, fold, and glue in place atop the turret in front of the commander's hatch. The gun is very delicate, though, and breaks too easily. A small and difficult to cut out and fit brace is shown as one solution. Reinforcing the gun with broomstraw or slivers of toothpick are also possible.
