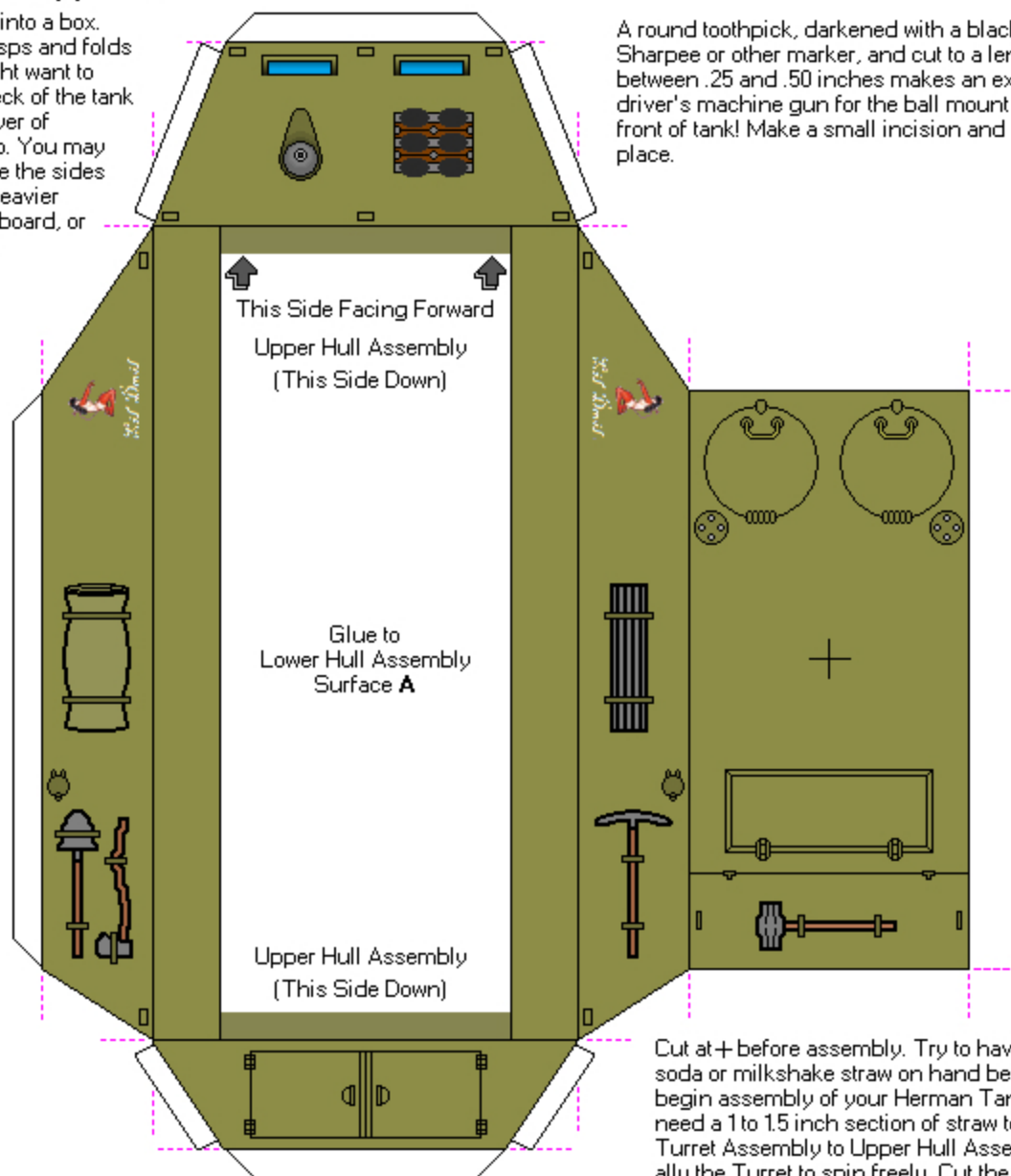


M-IV HERMAN MEDIUM TANK

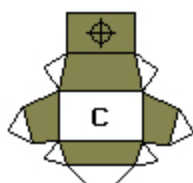
A: Main Hull, Upper Part

Fold tank body into a box. Keep edges crisp and folds sharp. You might want to reinforce the deck of the tank with an extra layer of cardstock or two. You may want to reinforce the sides and floor with heavier cardstock, cardboard, or popsicle sticks.



A round toothpick, darkened with a black or gray Sharpie or other marker, and cut to a length of between .25 and .50 inches makes an excellent driver's machine gun for the ball mount on the front of tank! Make a small incision and glue in place.

Cut at + before assembly. Try to have a clean soda or milkshake straw on hand before you begin assembly of your Herman Tank. You will need a 1 to 1.5 inch section of straw to attach Turret Assembly to Upper Hull Assembly and allow the Turret to spin freely. Cut the + just large enough to allow the section of straw to pass through with some resistance.



C: Gun Mount Assembly

It is easier to pre-cut the + on the front of the gun mount before assembly. Carefully cut out and lightly score the part on all of the fold lines. Use glue sparingly. Glue the gun mount assembly (C) to the turret before inserting tank gun.
